Report on the Audit of the Standalone Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone annual financial results of VARANASI SANGAM EXPRESSWAY PRIVATE LIMITED ("the Company"), for the year ended 31 March 2023, attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended) ('listing Regulations').

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the standalone annual financial results
